

RESOLUTION #36(B)-15, Rescinds Council direction to Town Manager to spend up to \$5,000 to have an engineer perform an evaluation

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2015 Town Council, by way of Resolution #36(A)-15 authorized the Town Manager to spend up to \$5,000 to have an engineer perform an evaluation in order to determine the feasibility of keeping the gymnasium located at the old high school; and

WHEREAS, during Town Council's Work Session on May 28, 2015, after learning of the extent of the damage to the gymnasium that occurred during the fire and after, Council members present (Ms. Goforth was not present) unanimously agreed to rescind the May 14th direction to the Town Manager regarding an engineer performing an evaluation and agreed that the gym should be torn down with the high school building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Town Council hereby rescinds Resolution #36(A)-15.
